VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

FASHION SHOW - Sunday, November 7 at Cotillion Banquets in Palatine. This unique luncheon/fashion show features student/parent/faculty modeling fashions from a variety of local businesses. That afternoon will also include solos provided by choir students and an exciting Silent Auction and Raffle. This is a great family event.....moms, dads, relatives, neighbors are all encouraged to attend. If you want to help plan the fashion show, sell raffle tickets on the day of the event, help with table decorations, etc., volunteer and we'll give you a call.

MIDDLE SCHOOL TOUR - Thursday, December 2 - We'll need chaperones, someone to drive the equipment van, make the reservations for our lunch stop. All choirs go on this tour that takes place during the school day.

CONCERT USHER - Take tickets and pass out programs at choral concerts.

CONCERT REFRESHMENTS - Provide punch and cookies after concert (cost covered by CAPS). Purchase items, set up and cleanup at a concert.

KICK-OFF CONCERT – September 28 - Concert in the east gym. General choir information and refreshments set up in Black Box Theatre for pre and post concert viewing. Good opportunity to get more detailed information on Choir program and to meet and greet other parents.

HAPPY HERSEY HALLOWEEN – October 29 – This event is run by the student Choral Council but they need adult help on the day of the event. We provide a safe trick-or-treat alternative to area children, ages pre-school thru 3rd grade, free of charge. Children trick-or-treat throughout the school, have stories read to them in the Library and play games and have refreshments in the cafeteria. We need help with set-up and clean-up.

CONCERT ATTIRE - Help with fitting of concert dresses and at end of year, take 15 or so dresses home to wash.

PIE SALE/FANNIE MAE CANDY SALE - Early November - delivery Thanksgiving week. Tally student orders and place order with company. Take delivery and distribute to students on pick up day.

MANNA PROGRAM - Assist on the day orders are delivered each month.

CHICAGOLAND SHOWCASE – March 4 & 5 - A huge undertaking. We need all parents to help with our biggest fundraiser of the year. This nationally-recognized showchoir competition runs Friday night and all day Saturday with setup starting on Thursday night. Moms, dads, alums, current students all pitch in to make this day a success. Although a showchoir competition, the funds earned benefit all choir students.

NEWSLETTER - You can be of help with the collating and getting the mailing ready to go out.

SEWING - We need help with both hand sewing and machine sewing including hemming choir dresses as well as alterations to choir dresses, showchoir costumes and Charles Dickens Caroler costumes.

CARPENTRY - From time to time, we will have projects that require a carpenter -- not major construction, promise!
