Dear Parents,

I wanted to let you all know that registration for the fall semester individual private music lessons is now open. For those of you who are new to our music program, private lessons are scheduled and taught through the D214 Community Education program. All private teachers are D214 employees.

For those of you who are returning, registration is the same as last year.

For those of you who are new, here's the info you need.

BE SURE YOU MENTION THAT YOU ARE A D214 STUDENT TO GET THE REDUCED RATE.

For this year, students have 5 options for enrollment in lessons:

- 1. 4-lesson pack
- 2. 9-lesson pack, paid in full
- 3. 9-lesson pack, paid in 2 installments
- 4. 17-lesson full semester enrollment, paid in full
- 5. 17-lesson full semester enrollment, paid in 4 installments

All of these options are available to register for online, including the installment options. Students can pay online by credit card, debit card, or electronic check. The only way to pay with cash is by coming to the CE office in Forest View and registering in person. If, near the end of the semester a student uses up their lessons and needs to add just 1 or 2 more to finish out the semester, they can do that as well, but they have to call us at 847-718-7700, or email us at ce@d214.org, to do that.

If you want to use your Student Account to pay for lessons or if you are receiving a scholarship from your Booster organization consult Mizz (sara.michael@d214.org) the following are your options:

- 1. You can register and pay online, then submit your receipt to the parent organization for scholarship reimbursement. This is our preferred method.
- 2. You can register online and pay with an installment plan, then submit your receipt, indicating the remaining balance due, to the parent organization. The parent organization can then cut us a check, which we will apply to the student's account, bringing their balance due to zero. However, Community Ed must receive the check before the due date of the next payment, or their system will automatically charge the student the remaining balance.

We highly recommend your student take private lessons, if possible. The benefits of the individual attention are exceptional.


Option 1 (Registration Link)

Follow the registration link on page 1 and click "Register for this Trip"



Option 2 (Trip Code)

- www.brtpayments.com to begin the registration process.
- Click 'Register' and create an account by entering your email address and desired password,
 accept the Terms of Service and Privacy Policy by clicking the checkbox and click 'Create Account"
- If you are a returning user, select 'Log In' in the right-hand corner and enter your email and password to access your existing account. You'll be prompted to select an existing trip or enter a new trip code (found in the top right corner of these instructions).



STEP 2: To reserve your spot you must:

- Complete all of the required information by clicking "Add Missing Info" (including personal info, medical info, package type, insurance selection, BRT Terms and Conditions and emergency contact
- Save a form of payment

(either a credit/debit card or bank information).

A partial registration, or a registration without saving a form of payment does not reserve your spot.
